Canadian Tire Money Contest

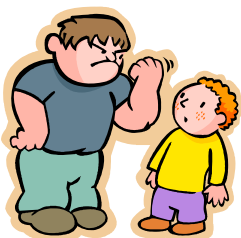

JK/SK Registration – Fall 2006

Registration will take place as follows:

WHEN: February 6 – February 17, 2006

TIME: 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 – 3:30 p.m.
(Monday through Friday)

ELIGIBILITY

Each prospective Junior Kindergarten student must be four years of age prior to December 31, 2006 and each prospective Senior Kindergarten student must be five years of age prior to December 31, 2006. Proof of age, i.e. Birth Certificate, Health Card and Immunization Record must be presented at the time of registration. Note that students currently registered (2005-2006 school year) do not have to register again.

Note: Please be advised that the Superior-Greenstone District School Board is considering full-time JK for the 2006-2007 school year. You are asked to drop by the school office to obtain information regarding full day JK and a survey requesting your input on a full day JK program.
