CHRISTMAS CAROLING

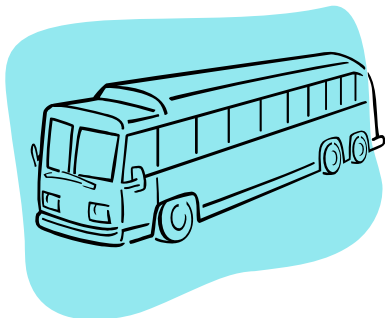

We now have our Tuck Shop up and running. Thanks to Tammy Turner, Marcia Newton and the School

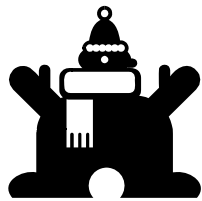
